

Assistant or Associate Professor, Physical Chemistry

Primary Responsibilities: (1) Instruction of general chemistry and physical chemistry courses (lecture and laboratory) for majors and non-majors, (2) instruction of nonmajor chemistry courses (lecture), (3) developing a research program with undergraduates, and (4) service to the University community.
