QUALIFICATIONS:

Jefferson (Philadelphia University + Thomas Jefferson University) seeks to fill several positions for full-time, 9 month, tenure-track and non-tenure-track faculty members with a strong commitment to chemistry education and scholarship. Educational responsibilities include teaching introductory and advanced chemistry courses including lectures and labs for chemistry and biochemistry majors and non-majors. The successful candidate will also mentor students pursuing independent study and are expected to supervise student research and to participate in student advising and assessment. Candidates should have a record of excellence in teaching at the college level; strong scholarship in their field(s) of expertise; and demonstrated commitment to the pedagogies of active student learning. Candidates who will thrive in a collaborative, interdisciplinary environment are strongly encouraged. Tenure track expectations include establishment of a sustainable research program that affords opportunities for undergraduate student participation is expected. While candidates with expertise in any field of chemistry will be considered, applicants in areas of mechanistic organic chemistry, inorganic chemistry, or analytical chemistry are especially encouraged.

EDUCATION REQUIRED:

Candidate must have a research doctorate or a foreign equivalent to a U.S. doctoral degree in chemistry, biochemistry, or related field.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will teach introductory and advanced chemistry lectures and labs for chemistry, biology and biochemistry majors as well as students enrolled in general education courses in chemistry, life sciences, and health sciences. The standard teaching load is 12 credits per semester, with course release reductions for pursuit of scholarly and/or administrative duties.
